### NO CUT Developmental Program

Open to all: 3<sup>rd</sup> grade through 11<sup>th</sup> Grade players (See AAU AGE CHART):

Since 1987 the Viking Club has provided basketball players from all over Wisconsin, Minnesota, and Michigan the opportunity to develop their skills on the court and prepare them for their school basketball seasons.

**VCTW believes strongly in the AAU motto: "Sports for all, Forever" and is one of the few clubs to offer a "no cut" developmental skills program for any player who wants to improve their game and have a place to play!**

*The Viking Club program is a "NO CUT" Developmental programs. For the cost of a typical camp, athletes will get 5 Skills Sessions/mini-camps and the opportunity to be formed into teams and play together in 3 tournaments.*

**The Viking Club program is open to all girls 3<sup>rd</sup> – 11<sup>th</sup> Grade, regardless of ability.**

*The Viking Club “Prepare to Succeed” Programs will focus more on Skills Sessions, but players will also get the opportunity to play in the Shootout Series Tournaments hosted by WI AAU. The players will be formed into teams by grade for each event, which may vary from tournament to tournament, depending on player availability. Teams will be coached in the tournaments by current and former college players.*

*This program is not formed in a typical TEAM FORMAT, but rather a skills program, with a chance to play as a group in a tournament setting.*

## **Important Information For ALL PROGRAMS**

***Schedule Conflicts: We recognize prior obligations will take precedence over playing. Family, church, or school commitments may arise that could prohibit a player from attending certain weekends, days, or games. However, since all entry fees, gym fees and administrative fees hinge on a full roster, we are unable to give discounts or refunds for missed events.***

***Players must notify [vikingclub@wivikingclub.org](mailto:vikingclub@wivikingclub.org) and the team coach at least 3 weeks in advance of known schedule conflicts.***

***Team Wisconsin: Athletes on Team Wisconsin teams must be able to commit to at least 80% of the team's events; the July events must have **a high level of commitment**, or have approval for absences before acceptance to the team.***

***Player invitations for Team Wisconsin will be emailed out within 48 hours of the last tryout . Athletes must respond within 24 hours with their acceptance to the team.***

***Our staff may move players to maximize the opportunity for the player and the team.***

***Transportation, hotel costs, and meals are the responsibility of the athlete and their family. The Viking Club/Team Wisconsin does not provide these things.***

## AAU Girls Basketball: New Age Determining Date for 2011

### 4th GRADE DIVISION

· A child must be in the 4th grade as of October 1, 2010 and **cannot** turn 12 prior to September 1, 2011.

### 5th GRADE DIVISION

· A child must be in the 5th grade as of October 1, 2010 and **cannot** turn 13 prior to September 1, 2011.

### 6th GRADE DIVISION

· A child must be in the 6th grade as of October 1, 2010 and **cannot** turn 14 prior to September 1, 2011.

### 7TH GRADE DIVISION

· A child must be in the 7th grade as of October 1, 2010 and **cannot** turn 15 prior to September 1, 2011.

### 8TH GRADE DIVISION

· A child must be in the 8th grade as of October 1, 2010 and **cannot** turn 16 prior to September 1, 2011.

### 9TH GRADE DIVISION

· A child must be in the 9th grade as of October 1, 2010 and **cannot** turn 17 prior to September 1, 2011.

### 10TH GRADE DIVISION

· A child must be in the 10th grade as of October 1, 2010 and **cannot** turn 18 prior to September 1, 2011.

### 11TH GRADE DIVISION

· A child must be in the 11th grade as of October 1, 2010 and **cannot** turn 19 prior to September 1, 2011.

### 12TH GRADE DIVISION

· A child must be in the 12th grade as of October 1, 2010 and **cannot** turn 20 prior to September 1, 2011.

\*The National Chair(s) may approve other participants at their sole discretion.

\*\*If an athlete wishes to play down one grade division, she must petition the National Chair and must meet all criteria established.
