Team Wisconsin Select is the highest level program in VCTW. Athletes on these teams must have a high level of commitment to play a "National Level" schedule, with a considerable amount of traveling to high level tournaments across the country.

Athletes considered for the Select teams in the high school divisions should already be receiving interest from Division I and II college programs.

Team Wisconsin Select will hold scheduled practices, based on the availability of the team. Practices will be held at various sites, trying to sites to accommodate the majority of the team and coaches. Team Wisconsin Select teams in the high school divisions may hold practices together and have a similar travel schedule.

Team Wisconsin Select will participate in the highest level events throughout the country, including AAU Showcases and Nationals.

Teams in the High School Divisions will play in several NCAA certified events during the NCAA evaluation periods. NCAA Certified tournaments give athletes maximum exposure to all levels of college programs throughout the country. Some tournaments may include: AAU events, USJN events, Adidas Midwest Classic, North Tartan Meltdown, MN AAU Summer Jam and Shootout Series Events.

Players in the High School Divisions will have player profiles provided to college coaches throughout the country. Some "Recruiting services" charge up to \$1000 for the same service. This is part of the Team Wisconsin program, not an additional "recruiting service".

Team Wisconsin Select teams will be selected by the coaches for the teams, Club Founder Keith Noll, as well as other VCTW staff.

Once an athlete is invited on the team, they will need to secure their roster spot with a non-refundable \$200 deposit towards their program fees. The final program fee will be based on the team's schedule. Typical fees tend to run \$850-\$950 at the high school levels and slightly less in the middle school levels, program fees can be broken down and paid in installments. Final program fees are based on each team's schedule.

Many times, additional donations are made to the team, as a whole, which will reduce each athlete's program fees. Athletes may fundraise and work off their program fees. Last year's Select teams worked admissions at our hosted events and earned a large credit towards their fees.
