Important Information For ALL PROGRAMS

Team Assignments: We will make initial team assignments during tryout (Team Wisconsin) and player placement (Futurestars and Viking Club) weekends.

If a player is unable to attend the Player Placement weekend for the Futurestars and Viking Club programs, we will assign them to a team.

FUTURESTARS and VIKING CLUB: Please notify us in advance if you are unable to attend the April 10th Placement (Viking Club) or April 17th Placement (Futurestars).

Our staff may move players to maximize the opportunity for the player and the team.

Schedule Conflicts: We recognize prior obligations will take precedence over playing. Family, church, or school commitments may arise that could prohibit a player from attending certain weekends, days, or games. However, since all entry fees, gym fees and administrative fees hinge on a full roster, we are unable to give discounts or refunds for missed events.

Players must notify vikingclub@wivikingclub.org and the team coach at least 3 weeks in advance of known schedule conflicts.

Transportation, hotel costs, and meals are the responsibility of the athlete and their family. The Viking Club/Team Wisconsin does not provide these things.
